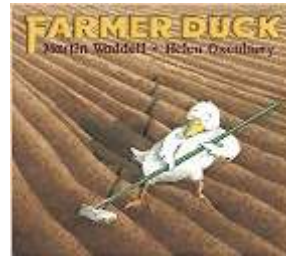


Knowledge

Definitions

Animal	Living things that are not plants or humans.
Fruit	The part of a plant that has seeds.
Vegetable	Part of a plant used a food.
Crop	Plants grown in large amounts for food e.g. wheat.
Harvest	The process of gathering crops.
Autumn	The season after summer and before winter.
Tractor	A large vehicle used on a farm..
Combine Harvester	A machine that cuts, threshes and cleans a crop.
Farmer	A person who owns or manages a farm.
