- There are different genres of music the ones we will be focusing on this half term are rap, old school and hip-hop.

- Hip Hop culture developed in the Bronx, New York, at the end of the 1970s.
- It featured graffiti, dancing and party music played by DJs on mobile sound-systems.
- The general style indicators of hip-hop music are MCing, rapping, drum and percussion backing loops.
- DJs would play different styles of music such as Funk, Latin or Rock in the instrumental breaks between the MCs talking.

## Vocabulary Definitions

<b>Pulse</b>	The heartbeat of a song
<b>Style Indicator</b>	Identifiers that show us the genre of the music
<b>Rhythm</b>	A combination of long and short sounds to make patterns
<b>Genre</b>	A style or category of music
<b>Pitch</b>	A range of high and low sounds
<b>Compose</b>	Creating and developing musical ideas
<b>Chorus</b>	A repeated section in a song which gives the main message
<b>Rapping</b>	Spoken or chanted rhyming lyrics.
<b>Verse</b>	The section of a song that has the same tune but different words
<b>Improvise</b>	To make up a tune and play it on the spot.
