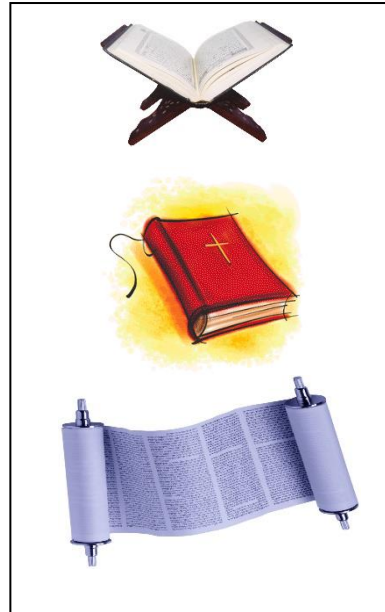


## Knowledge

## Vocabulary Definitions

Bible	Christian sacred text
Torah	Jewish sacred text
Qur'an	Muslim sacred text
Yad	A pointer used by Jewish people when reading the Torah
Ark	A cupboard or box where the Torah is kept
Parables	Stories that Jesus told to help people learn something or better understand his ideas
Holy / Sacred	People believe they are from God
Hebrew	The written language of the Torah
Arabic	The written language of the Qur'an
